### Job Summary:

Our analysis reveals the Gondola project is financially unsustainable, environmentally damaging, and will not solve traffic congestion. Instead, numerous proven, lower-cost solutions exist. In December 2023, our coalition partner Friends of Alta filed a lawsuit challenging the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) decision to install a Gondola system as the final solution to traffic issues in Little Cottonwood Canyon.
